

WHITE HERON ACCESSIBILITY:

As all of our properties are very old they all come with their own quirkiness and aren't always accessible for some disabilities. They are suitable for partially disabled guests, but not for those who have very limited mobility as in most the levels are different and most have stairs. The below are a snapshot of what we can offer guests with mobility issues, however we are happy to answer any queries or questions you may have regarding this and we may even have a solution for your needs. Unfortunately none of our properties have lifts or stanner stair lifts. In all cases it would be impractical. Assistant dogs are accepted in Sheriffs, Field and Gardeners Cottage.

Colloquy

The Colloquy is a substantial Victorian stable block and carriage house and is set over several floors. There are 2 bedrooms on the ground floor but access to the main house is via stone steps, a third bedroom which is on the ground floor in the main house is very accessible for a wheelchair user as access to this room can be made via the central clock courtyard through the main arch and then through a wide double door way. A fourth bedroom which is also a self-contained flat with kitchen has a walk in wet room too. We can allow separate access to the latter two bedrooms if this enables your guests. Doors and entrances are wide enough to allow wheelchair access.

The Lodge

The Lodge has a bedroom downstairs, but access to washing/showering facilities are upstairs so this property we wouldn't recommend for a wheelchair user – the stairs here are very steep and there are steps to enter the property from front and back. However, there is a downstairs toilet in this property.

Gardeners Cottage

All bedrooms are on the first floor, a separate wet room is downstairs and can be accessed by a weight bearing wheelchair user as can the stairs to access the bedrooms. Doors and entrances are wide enough to allow wheelchair access.

Forge

The main living/bedroom areas are all on one ground floor level, perfect for a weight bearing wheelchair user. A second bedroom is accessed via a spiral staircase, ideal for carers or family. Doors and entrances are wide enough to allow wheelchair access.

Field Cottage

This property has 2 bedrooms on the first floor along with the family bathroom, the stairs are open tread and steep. We wouldn't recommend this property to anyone with any known disabilities.

The Sherriffs

This property is set over 3 levels with all bedrooms being on either the first floor or second floor along with bathrooms. There is a ground floor toilet but due to the type of building this is again it would be very limiting for guests with disabilities but would be appropriate for a weightbearing wheelchair user. Doors and entrances are wide enough to allow wheelchair access.
